## Should the right of private prosecution exist?

Slightly uncomfortable at finding my name between those of Raymond Blackburn and Mary Whitehouse in the article by Mr A F Wilcox (18 October 1977), I would be grateful for the opportunity to make a point which may have some bearing on the question whether to retain the right of private prosecution, and if so to what extent. I brought the prosecution Mr Wilcox refers to in *defence* of freedom - in that case the freedom to play in and watch sporting events. That was the sole reason for my action. The Blackburn and Whitehouse prosecutions on the other hand were brought against the freedom of people to see what they wanted to see. 1
