1975	First person in Britain to use a computer to draft legislation (Sex Discrimination Act 1975).

1978	Publication of first edition of FB's <i>The Consumer Credit Act Manual</i> (third edition 1986).
1979	Co-founded Areopagitica Educational Trust (registered charity).
1979	Founded Towards One World (registered charity).
1980	Publication of first edition of FB's <i>Statute Law</i> (third edition 1990).
1980	Founded <i>Statute Law Review</i> .
1984	Publication of first edition of FB's <i>Statutory Interpretation</i> (fifth edition 2007).
1988	Helped to refound Oxford City FC (Chairman 1988-89).
1989	Publication of FB's <i>Victorian Railway Days</i> (novel).
1991	Publication of FB's <i>The Sex Code: Morals for Moderns</i> .
